Did you know?

- It takes a gallon of oil to make a new laser cartridge
- In North America, over 350 million cartridges are thrown out each year
- It can take as long as 450 years for a cartridge to decompose in a landfill

***Don't throw away your empty printer cartridges.
Recycle them and raise money for your school***

We will be recycling all our school empty, printer ink cartridges (**LaserJet or inkjet**) and all monies collected will be used to purchase additional computer supplies; headsets, cables, printer ink, etc. for all 3 schools.
